**SUBJECT:** "2022" Pavement Legends Program, City File # E20-011

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**REQUEST:**

The Department of Public Services requests City Council to authorize a blanket purchase order/ contract for the "2022" Pavement Legends Program to PK Contracting of Troy, MI in the amount of \$47,568.00 with a 5% contingency of \$2,378.40 for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$49,946.40, and further authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract on behalf of the City.

**REASON FOR PURCHASE:**

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) received bids for their "2022" County-Wide Pavement Legend Program. PK Contracting was awarded the RCOC contract on April 29, 2022 as the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder and has agreed to extend the same RCOC "2022" contract unit pricing to the City of Rochester Hills for the "2022" construction season.

The "2022" pavement legends program consists of removal and replacement of existing, and installation of new pavement cold plastic legends including "Left and Right-turn" Arrows, "Stop Bars", "X-Walks", "SCHOOL" and "ONLY" symbols, etc. The proposed pavement markings to be removed and replaced are those rated as poor or in need of replacement, when the City staff performed the "2022" condition rating inspections.

All replacement pavement legends conform with RCOC's recently awarded contract that was procured through a competitively bid process. Additionally, all legends materials are 3M Stamark Pavement Marking Tape Series 270 ES with application methods meeting 3M product manufacturers' guidelines and Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) specifications.

The "2022" Legends Program is essential to the City of Rochester Hills due to it enhancing the safety of road users, and pedestrians. These functional road special markings assist in reducing crashes, mitigating injuries and minimizing associated liabilities.
