President Opens the Floor for Nominations

President Closes the Floor for Nominations No Resolution is needed to close nominations		
If there are more nominations than positions: President asks for Roll Call Vote Council Members Vote		If there is exactly the number of nominees needed to fill positions President announces nominee(s) have been unanimously appointed
<b>Majority Votes</b> are elected	If no majority vote, nominee with fewest number of votes is dropped and voting continues until majority received	
Council President announces the winner
