- Significant impact due to it's large size

- Direct connection with the Clinton River
- Steep Slopes
- High quality wetlands
- Rare and old-growth tree canopy
- Wonderful wildlife habitat
- Important piece of the Oakland County Green Infrastructure vision


## Considerations

- Over the years, several developers have been interested in developing this property for homes or condos
- Property owners are looking to sell
- This parcel is a good fit with the intent of the Green Space Millage approved as approved by the voters:
- Protection of water resources, habitat protection, woodlands, recreational value and natural features
- Connectivity with other resources such as the Clinton River and Riverbend Park
