SUBJECT: 2015 Concrete Road Replacement Program - City File No. E15-001

REQUEST:

The Department of Public Services recommends awarding the contract for the *2015 Concrete Road Replacement Program* to Florence Cement Company of Shelby Township, Michigan and authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract on behalf of City. Staff has provided two (2) contract award amount options as follows:

- **Option 1**, award a contract in the amount of \$1,607,605.95 with a 10% contingency in the amount of \$160,760.60 to allow for quantity adjustments based on final measurements verified in the field for a total not-to-exceed construction cost of \$1,768,366.55. This option would utilize the current FY 2015 budgeted amount, however, some of the estimated project areas would be deleted from contract.
- **Option 2**, award the contract in the amount of \$3,039,021.50 with a 10% contingency in the amount of \$303,902.15 to allow for quantity adjustments based on final measurements verified in the field. This amount would require a budget amendment for both MR-03A and LS-03 and allow for completion of all estimated project areas for those funds. MR-03B (LDFA) work would still utilize the budgeted funds only.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

On Tuesday, March 10, 2015, the City received two (2) sealed bids for the *2015 Concrete Road Replacement Program* (bid tabs attached). Of the bids received, Florence Cement Company was the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder. The bid received from Florence Cement Company is 23% above the engineering cost estimate, which is shown on the attached bid tabulation. Work is expected to begin in May 2015 with a completion date scheduled early September 2015.

The Scope of Work includes:

Drainage structure adjust/recondition/reconstruct; installation of under drains; placement of aggregate base for concrete roads and drives, concrete pavement removal and replacement; restoration; and other miscellaneous items of work.

BUDGET:

Option 1 – Award Contract Utilizing Current Budget Amount

Funding is provided in the 2015 Adopted Budget. The project total is \$1,768,366.55 split as:

- [\$1,607,605.95 plus a 10% contingency of \$160,760.60]
- MR-01/03A Major Road Asphalt/Concrete Program \$198,347.85
 - [\$180,316.23 plus a 10% contingency of \$18,031.62]
- MR-03B L DFA Road Asphalt/Concrete Program \$195,000.00
 - [\$177,272.73 plus a 10% contingency of \$17,727.27]
- LS-01/03 Local Street Asphalt/Concrete Program \$1,375,018.70
 - [\$1,250,017.00 plus a 10% contingency of \$125,001.70].

Other costs associated with the project include geotechnical services (typically 2.5% of contractor payments) and survey & layout supplies such as stakes and paint. The amounts proposed are nearly equivalent to the total of the remaining budgets below and would not require any additional budgeted funding or amendments.

Option 2 – Award Contract as Bid

Funding is provided in the 2015 Adopted Budget. The project total is \$3,342,923.65 split as:

- [\$3,039,021.50 plus a 10% contingency of \$303,902.15] split as:
- MR-01/03A Major Road Asphalt/Concrete Program \$198,347.85
 - [\$180,316.23 plus a 10% contingency of \$18,031.62]
- MR-03B L DFA Road Asphalt/Concrete Program \$195,000.00
 - [\$177,272.73 plus a 10% contingency of \$17,727.27]
- LS-01/03 Local Street Asphalt/Concrete Program \$2,949,575.80
 - [\$2,681,432.55 plus a 10% contingency of \$268,143.25].

Other costs associated with the project include geotechnical services (typically 2.5% of contractor payments) and survey & layout supplies such as stakes and paint. This amount will be charged against the requested 10% contingency amount.

If approved by City Council, a 2nd Quarter 2015 Budget Amendment shall be brought forth to increase the capital project budget for LS-03. It is proposed to increase the General Fund Transfer-Out to the Local Street Fund to offset the increased project costs.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that City Council award Option 1 contract for the *2015 Concrete Road Replacement Program* to Florence Cement Company of Shelby Township, Michigan as the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder in the amount of \$1,607,605.95 and authorize the Mayor to execute a contract on behalf of the City.

The Department of Public Services also requests City Council authorization of a 10% contingency in the amount of \$160,760.60 to allow for quantity adjustments based on final measurements verified in the field for a total not-to-exceed construction cost of \$1,768,366.55.

The Department of Public Services staff will provide the following construction professional engineering services for this project: inspection, complaint resolution, and contract administration along with outside consulting services for geotechnical materials testing.
