AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 54-153, 54-154, 54-155, 54-156, 54-157, 54-163, 54-193, 54-226, 54-262 54-302, 54-466, 54-467, 54-469, 54-470, AND 54-471; IN CHAPTER 54, FEES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN, TO MODIFY FEES CHARGED FOR BUILDING PERMITS, PLAN REVIEW, FACTORY-BUILT BUILDINGS, CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY, DEMOLITION, RESIDENTIAL BUILDER LICENSES, PERMIT APPLICATION, PLUMBING ITEMS, ELECTRICAL CIRCUITS, MECHANICAL ITEMS, PARK ENTRY FEES, SHELTER RENTAL, COMMERCIAL USE OF PARK GROUNDS, MUSEUM, AND SPORTS FIELD RENTAL AND TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES, AND PRESCRIBE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS.

THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 54-153 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended as follows:

Sec. 54-153. Building permit valuation.

The building permit fee shall be based on the estimated cost of the project as computed from the current International Code Council (ICC) Building Valuation Data Report, exclusive of site work. The fee shall be based on the building construction valuation as follows:

(1) Up to \$1,000.00	\$ {	85.00 100.00

<u>Section 2</u>. Section 54-154 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended as follows:

Sec. 54-154. Plan review fees.

- (a) The building plan review fee shall be based on the total estimated cost of the project as computed from the current International Code Council (ICC) Building Valuation Data Report, exclusive of site work. Plan review fees shall be as follows:
 - (1) R-3 and U plan review shall be computed at 0.00162 of the estimated construction cost or \$85.00, minimum. This fee covers two reviews: the initial review and one re-review. A fee of \$85.00 per hour will be charged for additional reviews.
 - (2) All others shall be computed as follows:

- a. Zero dollars to \$1,250,000.00 shall be computed at 0.00244 of the estimated construction cost or \$\frac{165}{195}.00 \text{ minimum}.
- b. Over \$1,250,000.00 shall be computed at 0.0008 of the estimated construction cost plus the first \$1,250,000.00 at 0.00244.

This fee covers two reviews: the initial review and one re-review. A fee of \$85.00 per hour will be charged for additional reviews.

- (b) Review of site plans associated with planning commission activities, shall be charged at \$85.00 per hour.
- (c) Where review of construction documents is performed by city employees other than building department employees, the review fee shall be charged at \$85.00 per hour.
- (d) Plan review of hazardous materials shall be charged at \$85.00 per hour.
- (e) Plan review performed by building department staff for accessibility, energy, structural, mechanical, plumbing, electrical, and fire protection shall be charged at 15 percent of the building plan review fee or \$165.00 minimum. This fee covers two reviews: the initial review and one re-review. A fee of \$85.00 per hour will be charged for additional reviews.
- (f) Payment shall be in advance of the review based on estimated cost.
- (g) Where review of construction documents is performed by outside consultants, the review fee shall be charged at 1.25 times the actual cost. Payment shall be in advance of the review based on estimated cost.
- (h) High hazard occupancies (group H) will be charged an additional 25 percent of the calculated plan review fee.
- (i) Pre-qualification of special inspection agency \$85.00 per hour.
- (j) Each phased building permit will be charged an additional \$500750.00.
- (k) Expedited plan reviews performed by building department staff shall be charged at 1.5 times the normal plan review fee.
- (1) The building plan review fee for R-3 residential new house plans that are essentially duplicate, without material deviation, new house plans the city previously reviewed and approved from the same builder, for the same residential development project, under the same edition of the building code, shall be 50 percent of the plan review fee in subsection (a) above.

<u>Section 3</u>. Section 54-155 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended as follows:

Sec. 54-155. Factory-built buildings.

The permit fees for factory-build buildings shall be as follows:

- (1) Within the MH district, the fee shall be \$255270.00 (cover all the inspections performed) per dwelling unit.
- (2) In other districts, the fee shall be the same as the building permit valuation.

<u>Section 4</u>. Section 54-156 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended as follows:

Sec. 54-156. Certificate of occupancy.

The fees for certificates of occupancy shall be as follows:

- (1) Certificate of occupancy request not part of a building permit\$ 250.00

- (4) Change of Occupancy request _______\$ 50.00

<u>Section 5</u>. Section 54-157 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended as follows:

All contractors shall register their license with the city before work is commenced. Registration shall be valid until the expiration date on the license. This fee shall not be prorated. The fees for residential builder licenses, as provided in section 18-4, shall be as follows:
