Description: Gable roof upright and wing with rear ell. Two story upright, 1 1/2 story wing and 1 1/2 story rear ell. Common bond brickwork with brick water table. Angular arches over doors and windows. Mostly 4/4 windows. Louvered shutters. Bay window on east side has Tudor arches over windows. Porch on east side of rear ell has posts in storage. Front porch on wing has narrow chamfered posts. Two front doors from porch both have arched panel doors. Small wood frame rear ell in southwest corner of main house and rear brick ell. Recent metal roof porch with concrete floor on west side of rear ell. Enclosed rear porch addition with aluminum siding and concrete foundation has partly built deck. 3/1 kitchen windows (in rear ell) appear to have replaced an earlier, longer window. Some flat skylights added to rear ell. Newer brick chimney on west side.

Other Buildings/Features: Pumphouse to west of rear ell. Barn in rear. Gambrel roof storage shed behind barn recently moved to property from across the street. Remnants of orchard on east side.

Statement of Significance

As described in the 1907 Barnes Rochester Directory, the Eureka Fruit Farm was established in 1870 by H.W. Ostrom, who was 80 years old in 1907. The farm had 24 acres of bush berries with more varieties than any other farm in the township. Ostrom introduced the custom of drawing berries to Detroit by team, avoiding commission men, carrying his own cashier, and selling directly to the consumer. He had one of the most profitable berry farms in the state and employed 85 pickers at the height of the season. Paul Miller's family bought the house in 1974. According to Paul Miller there is a cistern under the kitchen floor and evidence for a kitchen stove.

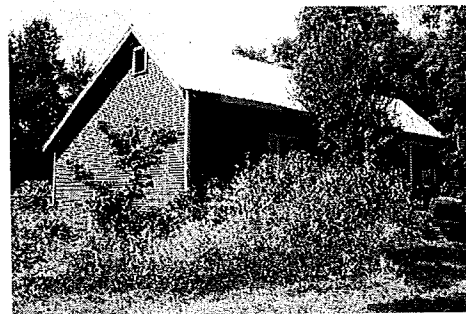
