Article VI

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt form Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

Article VII

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

- 2. This document is to be used pursuant to the provisions of Act 162, P.A. of 1982 by one or more persons for the purpose of forming a domestic nonprofit corporation.
- Article II The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized must be included. It is not
 sufficient to state that the corporation may engage in any activity within the purposes for which
 corporations may be organized under the Act.
- 4. Article III Complete item III(1) or III(2) as appropriate, but not both.
