 - 1) Upon dissolution, remaining assets must be used exclusively for exempt purposes such as charitable, religious, educational and/or scientific purposes.
 - 2) MODES Motor City Baseball Club must be operated to avoid liability for excise taxes under IRS sections 4941(d), 4942, 4943(c), 4944 and 4945(d)

 The nonprofit corporation is being established as an educational youth baseball program that is designed to develop baseball skills and provide an environment of competition.
