

2022 Local Road Improvement Program Application

BACKGROUND: Oakland County has established a Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) for the purposes of improving economic development in Oakland County cities and villages. The County intends this Program to assist its municipalities by offering limited matching funds for specific, targeted road maintenance and/or improvement projects on roadways under the jurisdiction of cities and villages.

PROJECT POLICIES AND GUIDELINES: The Oakland County Board of Commissioners and the Local Road Improvement Program Special Committee have established policies, procedures and guidelines for project consideration. AVAILABLE FUNDING: Oakland County's maximum contribution for projects in eligible cities or villages has been established within the distribution formula included as Attachment "B". The table shows you how LRIP funding is distributed for 2022 and the amount allocated to your community. The MAX COUNTY MATCH column is each community's allocation. If your project does not meet the MINIMUM PROJECT COST column amount, then your MAX COUNTY MATCH will be reduced. REQUIRED MATCHING FUNDS: A city or village participating in the Local Road Improvement Program shall match any funds authorized by the Oakland County Board of Commissioners in an amount equal to a minimum of 50% of the cost of the total project award. Funding shall be utilized to supplement and enhance local road maintenance and improvement programs. Funding is not intended to replace existing budgeted local road programs or to replace funding already committed to road improvements.

The roads selected this year, that are in need of replacement, are: Cobridge Dr & Ct, Dunedin Dr, Greenleaf Dr, Harlan Ct, Highsplint Dr, Ivy Wood Ct, Olympia Dr, Quincy Dr, Rochdale Dr, Valley Stream Dr, and Whitney Rd. A grand total of 18,200 square yards of concrete to be replaced, to improve our local roads.
