At its May 5, 2021 meeting, the Water Service Advisory Council adopted the following Resolution:

Offered by Hooper, seconded by Hoksch;

Whereas, the Water Service Advisory Council supports the concept that expenses of the water and sanitary sewer system must be supported by revenue from the users of the system and,

Whereas the Water Service Advisory Council supports the methodology for calculation of water and sanitary sewer rates and charges that reflect the direct and indirect costs of the water and sanitary sewer system consistent with industry guidance and to generate Water & Sanitary Sewer Fund revenues that meet respective system revenue requirements;

Therefore, be it resolved, that the Water Service Advisory Council recommends the rates as presented to the committee known as Option #2 / No Commodity Rate Change.

The Water Service Advisory Council further recommends that City Council adopt the water and sewer rates for the billing period July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022 as recommended by the Water Service Advisory Council.
