**SUBJECT:** Unleaded Gasoline and Diesel Fuel

# **REQUEST:**

City Council is requested to authorize the purchase of unleaded gasoline and diesel fuel to Petroleum Traders Corporation, Fort Wayne, Indiana and RKA Petroleum Companies, Inc., Romulus, Michigan in the amount not-to-exceed \$732,460.00 through January 31, 2016.

# **REASON FOR PURCHASE:**

The City participates with the Michigan Intergovernmental Trade Network (MITN) for the purchase of unleaded gasoline and diesel fuel. Based on bids received by the City of Sterling Heights, the lead city on behalf of the cooperative, Petroleum Traders, Inc. (unleaded fuel) and RKA Petroleum Companies, Inc. (diesel) received the split fuel award of the contract as lowest, responsive and responsible bidders for truck transport deliveries.

The current award for the purchase of unleaded gasoline and diesel fuel is a two-year extension at the bid factors competitively bid in 2011. The MITN group and the City of Sterling Heights have mutually agreed to exercise the option to renew and the extension has been awarded by the City of Sterling Heights City Council.

Cost for gasoline and diesel are calculated based on the Oil Price Information Service (OPIS) Daily Average for Detroit Area, plus the vendor's bid factor (delivery fee) per gallon. Below is a breakdown of pricing per gallon for truck transport deliveries of fuel. Wholesale pricing was based on the OPIS Detroit Rack Average on December 5, 2013.

Comparables with the State of Michigan MiDeal bid, the MITN cooperative bid offers a lower overall price for both gasoline and diesel fuel and will produce a yearly saving for Rochester Hills of approximately \$1,600.00.

With the award to the two lower bidders, the City has the ability to utilize favorable pricing based upon the type and quantity of fuel purchased. It also provides the City with a secondary source of fuel in the event of an emergency. Petroleum Traders and RKA have provided good performance over the first term of the contract. Additionally Petroleum Traders is the largest independent distributor of gasoline and diesel fuel in the country, utilizing local vendors, as RKA.

Prices charged to MITN members through the cooperative bid will fluctuate based on market conditions, but are considerably lower than consumer pump prices. Qualifying governmental entities are tax exempt, however, certain state and federal fees apply.

The City uses approximately 55,000 of unleaded gasoline and 65,000 gallons of diesel fuel annually. The cooperative purchases approximately 3,000,000 gallons of gasoline and 1,000,000 gallons of diesel fuel annually.
