SUBJECT:	FY 2021 – 4 th Quarter Budget Amendment / City	

REQUEST:

We are requesting that City Council approve the Mayor's proposed amendments to the 2021 Budget for the following funds: General Fund, Major Road, Local Street, Fire Operating, Special Police, RARA Millage, Pathway Maintenance, Tree, Water Resources, OPC Millage, ARPA, Green Space, Drain Debt, OPC Building Debt, Fire Capital, Pathway Construction, Capital Improvement, Sewer Division, Water Division, Water & Sewer Capital, Facilities, MIS, Fleet, Cemetery Perpetual Care Trust, Green Space Perpetual Care Trust, Brownfield Revolving, Brownfield Redevelopment Authority [Legacy], Local Development Finance Authority, and Museum Foundation Trust Funds.

BACKGROUND:

As required by the State's Uniform Budgeting and Accounting Act and by City Charter Section 3.7, the Mayor's Office has prepared the following recommended budget amendments to the current adopted FY 2021 Budget.

The FY 2021 4th Quarter Budget Amendments propose an increase in total revenues of +\$5,812,400 and a decrease in total expenses of (\$3,312,150). The increase in revenues less the decrease in expenses will have a net impact on citywide fund balances and retained earnings of +\$9,124,550. It is currently estimated that \$3,757,810 of capital projects and services not completed in FY 2021 shall be carried over to the FY 2022 Budget

The requested amendment amounts are detailed in both the attached Overview Report and Line-Item Detail Summary Report.

RECOMMENDATION:

We recommend that City Council approve the Mayor's 4th Quarter Budget Amendment to the FY 2021 Budget as proposed.
