SUBJECT:	Maintenance Agreement for LifePak 15

REQUEST:

City Council is requested to authorize the purchase of a three-year service agreement for Life Pak 15 (heart monitors/defibrillators) to Physio-Control, Inc., Redmond, Washington in the amount of \$30,164.40.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The Rochester Hills Fire Department has standardized its cardiac monitoring equipment to Physio Control, providing uniform operable heart monitors/defibrillators throughout the City and with local hospitals. Physio Control is the proprietary provider of all maintenance services for the LifePak 15 cardiac monitors. Physio Control is offering a 5% discount on maintenance service costs with a three-year contract. The savings to the City would be \$1,587.60 to enter a three-year contract versus contracting on a year-to-year basis. As part of the service plan, the City would receive a 15% discount on accessories and consumables.
