SUBJECT:	2018 High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) Grant Funding Acceptance

REQUEST:

It is requested that City Council accept grant funding from Oakland County, as received by the United States Office of Drug Control Policy, allocated to the City of Rochester Hills under the 2018 High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) Grant.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The Oakland County Narcotic Enforcement Team (NET) is a multi-jurisdictional task force. The mission of NET is to identify, investigate, and prosecute drug traffickers and dismantle their organizations. In January of 2010 the Oakland County Sheriff's Office Rochester Hills Substation assigned a Deputy to NET.

HIDTA Objective: To reduce drug trafficking and drug production in the United States by: Facilitating cooperation among Federal, State, local and tribal law enforcement agencies to share information and implement coordinated activities. Enhancing law enforcement intelligence sharing among Federal, State, local and tribal law enforcement agencies. Provide reliable law enforcement intelligence to law enforcement agencies needed to design effective enforcement strategies and operations. Support coordinated law enforcement strategies which maximize use of available resources to reduce the supply of illegal drugs in designated areas and in the United States as a whole.

For 2018, Oakland County has received a HIDTA grant from the United States Office of Drug Control Policy. If approved by City Council, the City of Rochester Hills will receive a portion of the grant totaling \$4,200.00. These dollars will be used to offset the overtime costs incurred by the assigned Deputy for HIDTA narcotic investigations.

For more than 15 years the Oakland County Narcotics Enforcement Team has received HIDTA grant dollars for overtime reimbursement. Oakland County Corporation Council recently reviewed this grant and determined that the Subrecipient Agreement between Oakland County and the City of Rochester Hills is now required.

BUDGET:

If accepted, the grant funds will be used in the Special Police Protection Fund to offset overtime costs incurred by the assigned Deputy for HIDTA investigations.
