Rochester Hills Letters of Support

In accordance with the Michigan Planning Enabling Act, the City of Auburn Hills, Oakland Township, and Shelby Township have all prepared and shared draft master plan updates. On behalf of the Rochester Hills Planning Commission, we have drafted and distributed the attached response letters. Auburn Hills

Oakland Township

The plan sets forth nine topical goals and supporting objectives related to natural features, managed growth, regional cooperation, aesthetics, recreation, historic preservation, economic health, housing and transportation. The plan reinforces the Townships desire to continue to be primarily a residential community which relies on other municipalities in the area to provide the bulk of their business needs. Shelby Township

The plan identifies four guiding principles, all of which Rochester Hills shares, including sustaining natural and community resources, diversifying housing, strengthening and transforming retail corridors, and linking land use and transportation. In addition, the plan makes specific recommendations for the Dequindre and Auburn area, and as part of our shared border, Rochester Hills encourages the redevelopment of this area as it will complement the recommendations of the recently completed Auburn Rd.
