SUBJECT: Chest Compression Devices

REQUEST:

City Council is requested to authorize the purchase of five (5) Automatic Chest Compression Devices to Physio-Control, Inc., Redmond, Washington in the amount of \$66,978.92.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The City's Purchasing Division issued Request for Proposals for the purchase of Automatic Chest Compression Devices utilizing the MITN system. The City received six proposal responses. The Request for Proposal required that the devices meet certain minimum technical specification requirements, as well as requesting pricing for a spare battery, carrying case and training for staff. Proposal responses received were evaluated by a committee consisting of staff from the Fire Department.

In evaluating responses received, three of the proposers who proposed the Defibtech unit could only provide out of state references, and all were distributors of the product rather than the manufacturer of the unit and lacked the ability to provide the needed support and training to the department required after the purchase of the unit. In evaluating the remaining responses, it was determined that the Resuscitation Internal device proposed is a two (2) piece unit. One of the technical requirements that were of utmost importance to the department was that the unit is fully self-contained and hands free.

The remaining two proposals received were for an Auto-Pulse unit and the Lucas 2 unit. Both vendors who proposed the units were deemed to be qualified and experienced vendors with proven track record of offering automatic chest compression devices that are utilized in our region. Based on the evaluation of all criteria, it is recommended to award to Physio-Control for the Lucas 2 unit based on the qualifications and experience of the vendor and providing the lowest cost proposal.
