SUBJECT: Public Hearing on the City of Rochester Hills Fiscal Year 2022 Proposed and 2023-

2024 Projected Budget Plan; and the Proposed 2021 Millage Rates

REQUEST:

In accordance with the City Charter Section 3.1 <u>Budget Procedure and General Finance</u>, Section 3.6 <u>Adoption of a Budget</u>, Section 4.1 <u>Power to Tax and Special Revenue</u>, and Section 4.2 <u>Charter Tax Rate & Special Voted Millage(s) Limitation</u> we have requested that City Council conduct a public hearing for the City of Rochester Hills Fiscal Year 2022 Proposed and 2023-2024 Projected Budget Plan, and the Proposed Winter 2021 Millage Rates (to be levied in December 2021), which will provide the tax revenues needed to support the Proposed FY 2022 Budget.

BACKGROUND:

In accordance with City Charter Section 3.5, City Council has set a Public Hearing date for the Monday September 13, 2021 City Council meeting to receive public comment on the City of Rochester Hills Proposed Budget and Millage Rates.

A copy of the City of Rochester Hills Proposed Budget and Millage Rates is on file and available to the public on the City's website, and during regular office hours in the Office of the Clerk, the Rochester Hills Public Library, the Older Person's Commission (OPC), and at the City Hall Resource Center. Notice that the City of Rochester Hills Proposed Budget and Millage Rates is on file, and the time and place of the public hearing thereon was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not less than fifteen (15) days prior to said hearing on the Proposed Budget and Millage Rates by the Council.

RECOMMENDATION:

We recommend that City Council conduct a Public Hearing on the City of Rochester Hills Fiscal Year 2022 Proposed and 2023-2024 Projected Budget Plan, and the Proposed Winter 2021 Millage Rates (to be levied in December 2021), which will provide the tax revenues needed to support the Proposed FY 2022 Budget in accordance with City Charter Section 3.5.
