SUBJECT: First Reading to add Division 4 Portable and Stationary Generators to Chapter 70 Article IV of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills to regulate the use of Portable and Stationary Generators.

REQUEST:

We are requesting that City Council accept the First Reading to add Division 4 Portable and Stationary Generators to Chapter 70 Article IV of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills, Oakland County Michigan to regulate the use of Portable and Stationary Generators.

REASON FOR REQUEST:

The unregulated use of portable or stationary generators to supply power to residential and non-residential buildings can create noise and emission nuisances that may detrimentally affect neighbors and may present possible fire and health dangers to the occupants of the premise.

This ordinance would regulate the use of portable and stationary generators in an effort to limit these noise and emission concerns.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that City Council accept the First Reading to add Division 4 Portable and Stationary Generators to Chapter 70 Article IV of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills, Oakland County Michigan to regulate the use of Portable and Stationary Generators.
