

Number of Deer-Vehicle Crashes* Rochester Hills 2004 - 2021








Deer/Vehicle Crash Locations




2017 thru 2021 Deer/Vehicle Collision (Density)








Aerial Deer Survey Results Rochester Hills









Deer Complaints 2011-2022



















2022/2023 DMAC Recommendations
