PREMIER ACADEMY ANNOUNCES PLANS FOR SECOND LOCATION IN ROCHESTER HILLS

Oakland Township, MI – Premier Academy, a locally-owned, Christian-based, early childhood education campus, is announcing site plans for a new location on the southeast corner of Adams and Tienken in Rochester Hills, Michigan.

The new campus' site plan proposes as a two-story, ten-classroom building with a fenced-in outdoor playground area. The campus will bring 22 new jobs, student intern opportunities to the area plus provide significant road improvements at the Adams/Tienken intersection.

“Our current campus in Oakland Township is at capacity,” says Premier Academy owner and Rochester-based businessman Jeff Schmitz, “which clearly demonstrates a need that our local families desire a private, preschool education experience close to home.”

The Adams/Tienken property is subject to conditional land use approval by the City. The developer has been asked by the Rochester Hills Planning Commission and the Road Commission for Oakland County to make modifications to its site and the adjacent roadways, which will be accommodated.
