The City's Historic Districts Study Committee has completed a study report for the creation of a Designated Historic District encompassing the National Twist Drill site located on northeast corner of Tienken and Rochester Roads.

After working with the City's consultant to prepare the Report, the Study Committee adopted the preliminary report on September 13, 2012. The report is now being transmitted to the Planning Commission and the Michigan State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO).
