

Hi Kristen,

In response to your email, we wanted to provide the following information to address the traffic concerns of the area's residents.

- 1. 22 staff members will be the max number of teachers at any given time. We start the day out with about 3-4 teachers at 6:30 am upon opening the school, and gradually as more students are dropped off, more teachers also arrive. At our highest point in the day we would reach 22 staff members. Around 11:30am we would begin to see a gradual reduction in staff and students until we close as the programs finish and parents pick up their children.
- 2. We have several flexible options for our programs. We open at 6:30 am and offer before care until 9am when our programs begin. We also have what is considered our school day between 9am and 3pm. After 3pm we offer aftercare until 630 when we close. We have a portion of students who get picked up between 11:30am and 1:00pm (depending on their classrooms lunch times that run between those hours) who aren't quite ready to stay a full day and need the half day scheduling. Our other students begin getting picked up around 2:45 and slowly leave upon the ending of our school day, or when their parents can pick up after work by 6:30pm. This staggers our flow of traffic quite well, which is why we never have an abundance of traffic at our current location or a backup like you would see at a school like Adams High. Most families are dropping their children off to Premier while passing by the school on their commute to work, or driving their other children to local schools also in the area.
- 3. We did do a follow-up with the current families enrolled in our Oakland Twp. location. Approximately 80% of our current students live within a 3 miles radius. Attached you will find a diagram of the families enrolled within 1, 2, and 3 miles.
