Greetings,

I have reviewed the RCOC plan for the Avon/Yates road construction and wanted to offer an opinion on the retaining wall materials. The use of the concrete cast blocks may have a negative impact on the area. I think a more agreeable and functional wall can be constructed using field stone, boulders, or a number of quarried stone/block. Natural materials would be more fitting to the historic district in my opinion. Colored concrete molds are more often seen and associated with freeways and industrial areas.

People admire the natural stone retaining walls on Adams road behind Meadowbrook. The stones are a characteristic we admire and appreciate in our community. Although probably not practical to duplicate those walls in this day and age, I think we could achieve something similar with this project. For many people Avon road will be a gateway into our city. The use of modern cast concrete (synthetic stone) will date this project and detract from the historic appeal of the buildings as well as the natural beauty of the park. The use of natural stone materials could be a great enhancement and appear timeless to future generations. In contrast, the cast block at the northeast corner of Tienken + Livernois is unsightly; it would be a shame to have the Yates house and barn obscured by a similar eyesore 9 feet tall.

This project is an opportunity to contribute something functional and worthy of preservation in the future. Because the RCOC has stated they are open to suggestions from the HDC, I hope you will consider and encourage the use of natural stone wherever possible.
