State Budget

Governor signed \$70 Billion Fiscal Year 21'-22' Budget on September 28th. This took effect October (includes School Aid Budget)

- Mix of general fund and ARP dollars
- \$500M deposit into the state's Budget Stabilization Fund
- Statutory Revenue Sharing will see a 2% (\$5.2M) increase added into the overall base for cities, villages, and townships
- \$100M of ARP funds for Community Revitalization Program and Placemaking grants to local units
- \$196M to repair or replace nearly 100 crumbling bridges in serious and critical condition
- \$65M for local road & bridge programs



Innovation Hills!!!

- State Budget FY 21'-22': \$500,000
- Budget Supplemental FY20: \$200,000
- State Budget FY18-19: \$500,000

Total grant dollars: \$1,200,000

- Special Election
 - House District 33, Rep. Doug Wozniak (R)
 - House District 74, Rep. Mark Huizenga (R)
 - House District 43, Rep. Andrea Schroeder (R)
- Redistricting
 - Public comment period began Oct. 20th
 - House, Senate, and Congressional maps to be voted on by Nov. 5th
 - o Final vote on Dec. 30th
 - Potential lawsuits to follow
