PY 2018 CDBG Application

REQUEST:

That City Council conduct a public hearing and adopt program allocations for the Program Year (PY) 2018 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

As part of the application process for CDBG funds, communities must hold a public hearing and the governing body must pass a resolution approving the planned use of funds. Oakland County's Community & Home Improvement Division does not yet have information on the exact amount of PY 2018 funding. The County has provided the City of Rochester Hills with an initial planning allocation of \$148,817 based on PY 2016 funding to complete the CDBG application. The City must allocate funds to eligible programs and projects in accordance with federal and county rules and regulations. The national objectives of the CDBG program are to assist low and moderate-income persons, to prevent or eliminate slums and blight, and to meet an urgent community need where no other funding is available.

The City of Rochester Hills has scheduled a public hearing on November 13, 2017, regarding the PY 2018 CDBG application and proposed funding allocations. The Community & Home Improvement Division has advised Administration that any City Council member who serves on a board of an organization receiving funds should excuse themselves from voting on the resolution. The Community & Home Improvement Division also recommends that organizations requesting funding and wishing to address City Council, should address Council during the public hearing.

In order to comply with federal regulations, the Community & Home Improvement Division is limiting the number of projects that communities can allocate funds for to four (4). The City currently has four projects: Minor Home Repair, Yard Services, Battered and Abused Spouses Services, and Emergency Clothing. Administration is asking City Council to approve the allocation of funding to mirror PY 2016 allocation.

\$121,817 Minor Home Repair (731227) – Provide accessibility modifications, ordinance compliance, and health and safety related repairs to low-income residents. Funds will allow approximately 40 projects to be completed. Eligible repairs include, but are not limited to, furnace or water heater replacements, roof repairs, plumbing, and electrical.

\$ 27,000 Public Services:

- **\$10,000 Public Services / Yard Services (732170)** Provide lawn mowing, snow removal, and spring and fall cleanups for approximately 70 low-income senior or disabled adult households.
- **\$ 7,000** Public Services / Battered & Abused Spouses (730137) Provide programs such as emergency shelter, legal, and counseling services for approximately 100 domestic violence victims or families.
- **\$10,000 Public Services / Emergency Services (730571)** Provides emergency clothing services to approximately 500 low-income residents.
