### ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 54-34, 54-54, 54-91, 54-154; 54-162; 54-191, 54-192, 54-196, 54-200, 54-201, 54-202, 54-203, 54-206, 54-207, 54-208, 54-210, 54-213, 54-226, 54-232, 54-262, 54-265, 54-267, 54-268, 54-302, 54-314, 54-317, 54-591, 54-742, 54-776 AND 54-806; TO REPEAL SECTION 54-50; AND TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 54-166, 54-193, 54-214 AND 54-215 IN CHAPTER 54, FEES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN, TO MODIFY FEES CHARGED FOR COPY COSTS, MAPS, PERMITS AND PERMIT CANCELLATIONS, REVIEWS, INSPECTIONS, LICENSES, AND SERVICES, EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, SURVEYS, COST RECOVERY, CIRCUIT, NONSOLID FUEL BURNING EQUIPMENT, TEMPORARY USE OF PUBLIC HYDRANT, MUNICIPAL WATER DEPARTMENT, SANITARY SEWER CONNECTIONS AND TO REPEAL CONFLICTING OR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES.

<u>Section 4</u>. Section 54-91 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended as follows:

# Sec. 54-91. – Liquor licenses.

The fees for liquor licenses as provided in section 6-37 shall be as follows:

- (1) Application for new license ......\$1,000.00
- (2) Application for transfer of license ......1,000.00

<u>Section 5</u>. Section 54-154 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended as follows:

#### Sec. 54-154. – Plan review fees.

- (a) The building permitplan review fee shall be based on the total estimated cost of the project as computed from the current International Code Council (ICC) Building Valuation Data Report, exclusive of site work. Plan review fees shall be as follows:
  - (1) R-3 and U plan review shall be computed at 0.00162 of the estimated construction cost or \$85.00, minimum. This fee covers two reviews: the initial review and one re-review. A fee of \$85.00 per hour will be charged for additional reviews.
  - (2) All others shall be computed as follows:
    - a. Zero dollars to \$1,250,000.00 shall be computed at 0.00244 of the estimated construction cost or \$165.00 minimum.
    - b. Over \$1,250,000.00 shall be computed at 0.0008 of the estimated construction cost plus the first \$1,250,000.00 at 0.00244.

This fee covers two reviews: the initial review and one re-review. A fee of \$85.00 per hour will be charged for additional reviews.

- (b) Review of site plans associated with planning commission activities, shall be charged at \$85.00 per hour.
- (c) Where review of construction documents is performed by city employees other than building department employees, the review fee shall be charged at \$85.00 per hour.
- (d) Plan review of hazardous materials shall be charged at \$85.00 per hour.
- (e) Plan review <u>performed by Building Department staff</u> for accessibility, energy, structural, mechanical, plumbing, electrical, and fire protection shall be charged at 15 percent of the building plan review fee or \$165.00 minimum. This fee covers two reviews: the initial review and one re-review. A fee of \$85.00 per hour will be charged for additional reviews.
- (f) Payment shall be in advance of the review based on estimated cost.
- (g) Where review of construction documents is performed by outside consultants, the review fee shall be charged at <u>1.51.25</u> times the actual cost. Payment shall be in advance of the review based on estimated cost.
- (h) High hazard occupancies (group H) will be charged an additional 25 percent of the calculated plan review fee.
- (i) Pre-qualification <u>erof</u> special inspection agency \$85.00 per hour.
- (j) Each phased building permit will be charged an additional \$500.00.
- (k) Expedited plan reviews performed by Building Department staff shall be charged at 1.5 times the normal plan review fee.

<u>Section 6</u>. Section 54-162 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended as follows:

### Sec. 54-162. – Cancellation of permit.

If a building permit is canceled, all fees shall be refunded except the application fee, 25 percent of the permit fee, \$85.00 per inspection, and plan review fees. <u>However, if a building permit expires due to 180 days of inactivity there will be no refund of any fees.</u>

<u>Section 7</u>. Section 54-166 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be added as follows:

#### Sec. 54-208. – Plan reviews.

The charge for each review by the fire department of one-family residential detached condominium, subdivision plat, site plan, unplatted land development, construction plan, or hazardous material plan shall be \$7585.00 per hour (one-hour minimum and 15-minute increments after initial hour).

<u>Section 19</u>. Section 54-210 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended as follows:

# Sec. 54-210. – Pre-incident surveys.

Michigan Fire Fighter Right-to-Know Site specific fee÷ of \$150.00 will be added to the initial inspection cost for all occupancies that fall under this category.

- (1) The city shall charge fees associated with an incident related to electric service incidents to include, but not limited to downed wires, transformer fires, and downed utility poles. The charge will be based on actual costs and expenditures (one-hour minimum) and billed to the responsible party or directly to the electric utility company.
- (2) The city shall charge fees associated with an incident related to gas service incidents to include, but not limited to, struck gas lines, malfunctioning gas line distribution stations, or other gas service issues. The charge will be based on

actual costs and expenditures (one-hour minimum) and billed to the responsible party or directly to the gas utility company.

<u>Section 21</u>. Sections 54-214 and 54-215 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be added as follows:

# Sec. 54-214. – Stand-by.

Department equipment or personnel for the purpose of providing standby fire, rescue, or emergency medical services necessary to support a nonemergency event/situation, will be billed to the responsible party at the hourly rates established under 54-201. The Department may reduce or waive any charges for such services at the discretion of the Fire Chief.

#### Sec. 54-215. – Motor vehicle accidents.

When the fire department responds to a motor vehicle accident, actual costs incurred by the department in responding to and mitigating such incident shall be imposed upon the responsible party, including, but not limited to:

(1) A fee at the established rate for the apparatus, and other items required, in the determination of the officer in command, to respond and be present and/or to stand by at the scene of the emergency response. Such fee shall be for each hour or fraction thereof that apparatus and other items are used or are required at the site by the officer in command. Such costs may include, but are not limited to; wages, salaries, fringe benefits, insurance, and other costs which may be a part of the city's established rates for full-time and part-time personnel, whether incurred at regular or overtime rates. Such personnel related charges shall commence at the time personnel are dispatched to the emergency incident and shall continue until all personnel have concluded their related responsibilities. Fees for Emergency Medical Services will be incurred separately under Section 54-203.
