SUBJECT:	2020 HMA Road & Pathway Rehabilitation Program Contractor - City File No. E20-003

REQUEST:

The Department of Public Service requests that City Council authorize a blanket purchase order/contract for the 2020 HMA Road & Pathway Rehabilitation Program to Pro-Line Asphalt of Washington, Michigan in the amount of \$1,547,628.00 and authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract on behalf of the City.

The Department of Public Service also requests City Council authorization of a 10% contingency in the amount of \$154,762.80 to allow for quantity adjustments based on final measurements verified in the field for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$1,702,390.80.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

On Wednesday, February 19, 2020, the City received sealed bids for the 2020 HMA Road & Pathway Rehabilitation Program (bid tabs attached). Of the bids received, Pro-Line Asphalt was the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder. The bid received from Pro-Line is 0.02% over the engineering cost estimate, which is shown on the attached bid tabulation. Work is expected to begin in March 2020 with a final completion date of September 6, 2020.

The Scope of Work includes:

Pathway Construction

The project includes rehabilitation of approximately 3,800 feet and new construction of approximately 1,000 feet of 8 foot wide asphalt pathway along the east side of *N. Crooks Road between the north side of Clinton River and Avon Road.*

Road Rehabilitation

The scope of work for *Lockmoore Court (Golf View Estates)* consists of removal of existing asphalt, installation of 6 inch 21AA aggregate base, edge drain, and installation of 6 inches of HMA. Work also involves localized concrete curb and gutter removal and replacement, possible undercuts, and reconstruction for ADA compliant sidewalks.

The scope of work for Austin Avenue (Commerce Park of Rochester Hills) includes a full width 3 inch depth surface mill and fill. Work also includes localized concrete curb and gutter removal and replacement, base and crack repairs.
