SUBJECT: 2017 Memorial Day Parade – May 29, 2017

REQUEST:

The Department of Public Services requests City Council to adopt a resolution to satisfy the requirements as outlined under the Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) annual permit for the Greater Rochester Memorial Day Parade to be held on Monday, May 29, 2017.

BACKGROUND:

The Greater Rochester Memorial Day Parade is hosted by the Cities of Rochester Hills and Rochester and is sponsored by various associated veteran organizations. The parade will begin at 10:00 a.m. at Mt. Avon Cemetery within the City of Rochester and run along First Street, then southerly along Castell Street, then westerly along Harding Road to Livernois Road, and finally Livernois Road southerly to Veteran's Pointe Park, concluding at 12:00 p.m.

The parade will result in the closure of the entire length of Harding Road and Livernois Road between Harding and Drexelgate Parkway, as well as, Avon Road at its intersection with Livernois Road.

The City of Rochester Hills has a 2017 annual RCOC permit to conduct community events, such as parades. The CITY is required to comply with RCOC permit requirements and will provide to RCOC offices a City Council resolution supporting this event a minimum three (3) days prior to the day of the event. A CITY resolution is only necessary for the portion of the event to be held along Livernois and Avon Roads. The Department of Public Services will provide traffic control services along the complete parade route with the presence of Oakland County Sheriff personnel.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Public Services recommends that City Council adopt the resolution for the Greater Rochester Memorial Day Parade to be held on Monday, May 29, 2017.
