


#### **2016 Deer/Vehicle Crash Locations**




#### **Aerial Deer Survey Results Rochester Hills**

(2017 Results not available due to weather)




## Number of Deer-Vehicle Crashes\* Rochester Hills 1999 - 2016

## **2017 RECOMMENDATIONS**

# **Continue and expand 2016 recommendations** →

- Increase number of changeable message boards to 6 (from 4) in high deer/traffic crash areas and expand time period from October 1 – December 1 not to exceed \$6,000 plus 2016 funds (DMAC Resolution)
- Continue aerial deer count survey (DMAC Resolution)
- Continue with Fall 2017 and Spring 2018 educational campaign on utility bills
- Maintain reflective tape on city controlled deer traffic signs

## **2017 RECOMMENDATIONS**

# **New Actions**

 Change moveable sign message to "High Deer Crash Area, Deer Alert, Reduce Speed" (instead of "Don't Veer for Deer")

- Add one solar flashing LED deer road sign for trial in high deer crash area after engineering review of feasibility- (\$4,000)
- Establish Community Outreach Program
  - Annual Deer Gardening Seminar beginning March/April 2018
  - Publish Seasonal Deer Management Brochure Spring 2018
  - Establish community partnerships with local garden/nursery stores
