SUBJECT: Recycling Incentives Rewards Program

REOUEST:

City Council is requested to approve the award of a contract for the City's Recycling Incentives Rewards Program to Recyclebank LLC., New York, New York for a five (5) year contract term.

City Council is requested to waive Section 2-273(b) the 3-year requirement for long term contracts, under Section 2-281, which allows City Council the authority to waive any regulation or procedure pertaining to purchasing, deeming it to be in the best interest of the City to allow a 5-year contract.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The City issued a Request for Proposals for the City's solid waste, recycling, and yard waste collection, transportation, processing and disposal services. As a result of the Request for Proposals process and subsequent negotiations with GFL Environmental USA Inc., the program has been finalized. As part of the negotiation process it was determined that there was a direct benefit as it relates to the ability to have control over the contract for the City's Recycling Incentives Rewards Program as well as a cost benefit. The features of the program are outlined and included with this Agenda Summary for City Council's review.

The waiver of the 3-year requirement for long term contracts is being requested, and is only requested, when it is identified to be in the best interest of the City. The City is very mindful, when requesting the waiver and has only done it under limited circumstances, and when there is significant financial benefit to the City and its residents in doing so. Some examples would be with our EMS billing provider service, print management services contract, or maintenance service contracts for patient transport cots. The City was able to secure better pricing and realize savings by contracting for an extended period of time.
