SUBJECT: Cross Connection Program Management Services

REQUEST:

City Council is requested to authorize the issuance of a blanket purchase order/contract for cross connection program management services to HydroCorp, Troy, Michigan in the amount not-to-exceed \$267,624 through June 30, 2021.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The Michigan Safe Drinking Water Act requires water utilities to have comprehensive cross connection control programs for the elimination and prevention of all cross connections. The City solicited Request for Proposals utilizing the MITN system and only one (1) response was received. The Purchasing Division conducted research to determine if there were other companies that could provide these services and found that HydroCorp was the company that was providing this service to most municipalities in our area and the other company that provides the service is located out of Owosso and typically can't be competitive in this market based on their capacity and distance. The City has utilized HydroCorp over the past three (3) years for their cross connection program management services and has been satisfied with the services received and recommend award of the contract to HydroCorp.
