**Traffic Study Summary
For Nawakwa & Hickory Lawn
“No Standing, Stopping, Parking” Sign Installations**

April 1, 2005

Background

On March 18, 2005, the City received resident complaints regarding overflow parking along Nawakwa and Hickory Lawn due to the new C.J. Mahoney’s Pub.

Summary

Based upon several field visits by the OCSD and further complaints from residents, it was determined that the primary on-street overflow parking was occurring on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday evenings.

In order to alleviate the overflow parking situation, the OCSD recommended installing “No Stopping, Standing or Parking” along both sides of Nawakwa, from Shadywood to Rochester, and along Hickory Lawn, from Rochester to approximately 430’ west of Rochester, between the hours of 7:00 pm and 2:00 am Thursdays through Saturday.

Conclusion

Based on the site evaluation, staff recommends issuing **TCO PK-84.1 “No Parking between the hours of 7:00 pm and 2:00 am Thursday through Saturday within the right-of-way of both sides of Nawakwa from Shadywood to Rochester”** and **TCO PK-84.2 “No Parking between the hours of 7:00 pm and 2:00 am Thursday through Saturday within the right-of-way of both sides of Hickory Lawn, from Rochester to a point four hundred (430) feet westerly thereof.”** to eliminate the overflow parking from C.J Mahoney’s during these hours.
