SUBJECT:	Support for Grant Application and Matching Funds – Clinton River Trail Look & Feel Project

REQUEST:

Due to incorrectly stated language, we are requesting that the Rochester Hills City Council rescind and replace Resolution RES0028-2013 passed on February 11, 2013 to approve a grant application to the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund for a signage and amenity package developed by the Friends of the Clinton River Trail with a revised Resolution.

BACKGROUND:

A request was brought before City Council on February 11, 2013 for the approval of a grant application to the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund for \$31,250 as the required 25% match for the \$125,000 signage and amenity package developed by the Friends of the Clinton River Trail. The Resolution from February 11, 2013 incorrectly indicated that the grant request totaled \$31,250 which in fact is the intended 25% match of funds for a \$125,000 project.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Parks & Forestry Department is requesting that City Council rescind the Resolution RES0028-2013 passed on February 11, 2013 to approve a grant application to the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund for a signage and amenity package developed by the Friends of the Clinton River Trail and replace it with a revised Resolution.
