**SUBJECT:** Green Space Preservation Millage Proposal

At the June 1, 2005 City Council Meeting, Council adopted Resolution RES0172-2005 directing the City Attorney to review the propose Open Space Ballot Proposal language and return it to Council for consideration and possible approval at the June 22<sup>nd</sup> Council Meeting. Attorney Staran has worked with the Open Space Ad Hoc Committee regarding the proposed ballot language and the Millage Proposal to Provide Funding to Permanently Preserve Green Spaces and Natural Features within the City of Rochester Hills it is ready for Council's consideration.

The resolution containing the ballot language has been attached for your consideration. Please note that although the candidates' deadline for submitting petitions for the Primary Election is June 21<sup>st</sup>, a candidate still has seventy-two (72) hours to request to remove his/her name from the ballot. Therefore the resolution contains a clause that if a citywide primary election is not held the Millage Proposal to Provide Funding to Permanently Preserve Green Spaces and Natural Features within the City of Rochester Hills will be moved to the November 8, 2005 General Election.
