**SUBJECT:** Second Reading & Adoption – Ordinance to amend Section 138-1074 of Chapter 138,

Zoning, of the Code of Ordinances to update and modify definitions and regulations

governing Adult Businesses

At the May 18, 2005 City Council Meeting, Council accepted for first reading an Ordinance to amend Section 138-1074 of Chapter 138, Zoning, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills, Oakland County, Michigan, to update and modify definitions and regulations governing Adult Businesses, to supplement the Statement of Purpose for the regulations, to repeal inconsistent ordinances, and to prescribe a penalty for violations. Council at its June 1, 2005 Meeting accepted this Ordinance for Second Reading and adoption and upon realization that this Ordinance did not go before the Planning Commission for a public hearing rescinded it and sent it to the Planning Commission for review and recommendation. The Planning Commission held a public hearing on July 19, 2005 and at the conclusion of the public hearing the Commission adopted a motion to recommend approval to City Council.

Attorney Staran at the June 1, 2005 Council Meeting confirmed that it was not necessary to rescind Council's acceptance of the first reading and upon recommendation of the Planning Commission this item could then be brought back to Council for second reading and possible adoption. A resolution for your consideration for acceptance for second reading and adoption has been included in the packet.
