Dear Ed.

I have received the notice of the public hearing at the regular zoning board of appeals meeting on January 11, 2017. I am concerned with File No. 16-033. The request for approval of a crematorium facility in all or part of this property is not compatible with light industrial zoning and would potentially conflict with current and/or future owners and tenants of my property, which is directly adjacent and in very close proximity to the subject property. I am very concerned that there is a current conflict that would arise with the occupants and customers of my building. I am further concerned that future property value, sale or lease-ability to many potential light industrial users would be negatively impacted by the risks and consequences associated with a crematorium.

I am in receipt of at least one current strong objection from an occupant of my building and the outcome would likely be that they would move from our facility. This is not acceptable and would disrupt my business and proper use of my building.
