2018 Budget Highlights

(approved by the OPC Governing Board)

Revenue - \$4,302,200

Expenses - \$4,265,900

Overall expenditures up 1.7% - 2017 Budget

Surplus - \$36,300 (added to contingency fund)

Personal Expenditures down 4.4% since 2015 (largely headcount reductions)

Budget Comparison year over year:

- 2015 \$4,424,292
- 2018 \$4,231,200 (headcount minus 4)

Reserve Fund will be increased by \$131,700 over the next 3 years
