The Plan - Six Phases

- Phase I Trails & Plantings
 - Base parking lot in progress / complete by spring 2018
 - 1st Mile trail loop and restrooms planned for summer 2018
- Phase II Community Water Feature area
 - Construction starts spring 2018 (or earlier)
- Phase III Play Areas & Sensory Garden
 - Sensory Garden plantings starting fall 2017, complete spring 2018
 - Design/community input process for play areas starting soon
- Phase IV Observation Areas & Art
- Phase V Community Structure
- Phase VI Bridge Connections



Innovation Hills

City Investment (\$450,000) – includes \$150,000 match for received grant

Partnerships Received (\$775,000)

- \$400,000 of in-kind services to construct portion of parking lot and paved trails
- \$155,000 in private/business donations
- \$150,000 grant from Land & Water Conservation Fund for boardwalk and restrooms
- \$30,000 grant from the Brooksie Way
- \$40,000 Gro1000 grant from Scott's Miracle Gro
