

Infants and Toddlers

Premier Academy offers a loving and nurturing environment for infants and as young as six weeks old. These classrooms are specifically designed to provide your child excellent individualized care and safety while also providing a stimulating environment for them to explore and learn. As the children grow and reach each milestone, our teachers are specially trained to evaluate and adjust the lesson plans based on each child's stage of development.

Our infants and toddlers are promoted based on the child's development to ensure appropriate toys and activities are available for each stage. As the infants become toddlers, the lesson plans will begin to include sign language to aid in communication as verbal language skills are being developed.

With this curriculum, preschool children fully learn each letter, including how it sounds and how to write it. They will also learn numbers and the number values while learning to write each number.

Colors, shapes and calendar skills are also included in the daily lesson plans, along with saying the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States flag.

To ensure your preschooler receives a strong foundation, the children have a weekly bible story and lesson. These lessons will reinforce our goals of teaching the children self-confidence and independence, respect for themselves and others, the importance of a sense of responsibility for their own actions and for the well-being of others. By the end of the preschool years, our students have the necessary skills to succeed in the classroom in Pre-Kindergarten and beyond, and they have developed a love of learning that will last them a lifetime.



Montessori Method

The Montessori method is an educational approach to teaching children based on the research and experiences of Italian physician and educator, Maria Montessori (1870-1952). It arose essentially from Dr. Montessori's discovery of what she referred to as "the child's true normal nature".


The role of the teacher is to watch over the environment and remove any obstacles that would interfere with this natural development. The teacher's role of observation includes experimental interactions with children, commonly referred to as lessons, to resolve misbehavior or to show how to use the various self-teaching materials that are provided in the environment for the children's free use.




Premier Academy has taken the Montessori Method, created by Maria Montessori in 1907, and brought it into our own classrooms to create an atmosphere conducive to learning while following the "true nature" of the child. All of our certified teachers are trained to help their classrooms of children use the natural materials and tools of the classroom to direct their own learning through language arts, math, science and much more.

Premier has separated their classrooms so that the Montessori Method can be applied the way it was intended. Students' ages 3 through 6 will be in one of our many combined classrooms. Here, students will continue to develop their skills of learning through individual work and presentations made by the teacher as well as through the mentoring between older and younger students. Here we can begin to see our students grow as leaders as well as develop a sense of empathy for other students, control over their own bodies and an overall sense of peace while learning at a rate them and their teacher feel comfortable with.

Pre-Kindergarten

Using the A Beka Book curriculum, students in Pre-Kindergarten classes at Premier Academy learn to use their skills in phonics to blend letters together and read. Taught by degreed teachers, a strong foundation in reading is the focus this final year before entering Kindergarten. Students will begin with a review of the short vowels, and then move to reading three-letter words. As the year progresses, students will begin to learn the rules for recognizing and reading words with long-vowels, and by the end of the year, will be able to read sentences and stories with one- and two- vowel words.

While the focus is on reading, these students will also have daily assignments to expand their knowledge of number values and concepts and will begin to learn simple addition. They will also have bible lessons and lessons in social studies and science. During this time, the students will learn about the world we live in, our place in this world and how we can help to care for ourselves, others and our world.

At the end of the Pre-Kindergarten year, these students are fully prepared to take the next step in their education and enter Kindergarten. They will take this monumental step into the schoolage years with a solid academic foundation firmly in place and a love of learning to last them a lifetime.


