Resolved, that the Rochester Hills City Council hereby authorizes the award of a blanket purchase order/contract

for the 2019 Concrete Road Replacement Program to Florence Cement Company, Shelby Township, Michigan in the amount of \$2,478,875.00 with a 5% project contingency in the amount of \$123,943.75 for a total not-to-exceed project amount of \$2,602,818.75 and further authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement on behalf of the City.
