Continue educational campaign (fall 2018 and spring 2019).

Establish community partnerships with local garden and grocery stores to get wider distribution of deer brochure.

Maintain the reflective tape on city controlled deer signs.

Continue movable message sign, (high deer crash area, use caution).

Use any unallocated funds from 2018 to put toward the movable message boards, to increase the time period from Oct 1 to Jan 1, 3 weeks at each location.

Increase budget for 2019 for additional time for movable deer signs (3 months).
