SUBJECT: Approval of grant request and matching funds – Michigan Council for Arts and Cultural Affairs

REQUEST:

The City of Rochester Hills has submitted a grant request for \$100,000 to the Michigan Council for Arts and Cultural Affairs Capital Improvement Program to rebuild the Equipment Barn at the Rochester Hills Museum.

Approval is sought for this grant request and to provide 1:1 matching funds if the grant is awarded.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The rebuilding of the Equipment Barn is the next major capital improvement project listed in the 2014 *Rochester Hills Museum at Van Hoosen Farm Preservation and Adaptive Use Master Plan*.

The Equipment Barn is listed in the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) (PK-03F). Updated cost projections in March 2019 show this building's cost estimate at \$798,000. This CIP project shows funding of 75% provided by the City (\$598,500) and the Museum providing the remaining 25% (\$199,500) through fundraising. To date, the Museum has raised \$60,000 for the project.

Grant notification will occur in October 2019.

BUDGET:

Funding for the construction of the Museum Equipment Barn will be included in the FY 2020 Proposed Budget.
