**The Road Commission for Oakland County will submit a grant application for funding in the amount of \$2,000,000 to complete an Environmental Assessment on Adams Road from Hamlin Road to Walton Boulevard in Rochester Hills, Michigan. The BUILD Grant program offers planning grant funds to be awarded to projects related to preconstruction planning activities such as master plans, risk assessments and environmental assessments. The Road Commission for Oakland County, City of Rochester Hills and Oakland University are evaluating alternatives for future widening reconstruction project. The Environmental Assessment is the first federally required step for this project and will study the widening of Adams corridor to improve safety and reduce traffic congestion. Adams Road serves as a direct connector to residential areas, Oakland University and commercial zones. There are several active developments both private and public sector-driven that will enhance economic productivity in the project area. It is important to plan for this future growth and provide a safe and efficient thoroughfare for motorists.**
