## Title

Request for Acceptance for Second Reading and Adoption - An Ordinance to amend Sections

138-8.600.A, 138-8.604, 138-11.204, Table 14, and 138-11.302 of Chapter 138, Zoning, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills, Oakland County, Michigan, to replace the reduced FB minimum parking requirements with a reference to the Article 11 minimum parking requirements, to delete minimum parking requirements as a modifiable standard in the FB district, to increase the multiple family visitor space requirement and to exclude garage, carport and driveway spaces from counting as required visitor spaces, to copy standards for tandem parking spaces from Section 138-6.406 to apply to all residential districts and to ensure consistency across various ordinance sections; to repeal conflicting or inconsistent ordinances, and prescribe a penalty for violations

## Body

**Resolved**, that an Ordinance to amend Sections 138-8.600.A, 138-8.604, 138-11.204, Table 14, and 138-11.302 of Chapter 138, Zoning, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills, Oakland County, Michigan, to replace the reduced FB minimum parking requirements with a reference to the Article 11 minimum parking requirements, to delete minimum parking requirements as a modifiable standard in the FB district, to increase the multiple family visitor space requirement and to exclude garage, carport and driveway spaces from counting as required visitor spaces, to copy standards for tandem parking spaces from Section 138-6.406 to apply to all residential districts and to ensure consistency across various ordinance sections; to repeal conflicting or inconsistent ordinances, and prescribe a penalty for violations is hereby Accepted for Second Reading and Adoption and shall become effective on Monday, December 21, 2020 following its publication in the Oakland Press on Sunday, December 20, 2020.
