SUBJECT: PY 2022 CDBG Application

REQUEST:

That City Council conduct a public hearing and adopt program allocations for the Program Year (PY) 2022 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

As part of the application process for CDBG funds, communities must hold a public hearing and the governing body must pass a resolution approving the planned use of funds. Oakland County's Community & Home Improvement Division does not yet have information on the exact amount of PY 2022 funding. The County has provided the City of Rochester Hills with an initial planning allocation of \$164,632 based on PY 2020 funding to complete the CDBG application. The City must allocate funds to eligible programs and projects in accordance with federal and county rules and regulations. The national objectives of the CDBG program are to assist low and moderate-income persons, to prevent or eliminate slums and blight, and to meet an urgent community need where no other funding is available.

The City of Rochester Hills has scheduled a public hearing on November 15, 2021, regarding the PY 2022 CDBG application and proposed funding allocations. The Community & Home Improvement Division has advised Administration that any City Council member who serves on a board of an organization receiving funds should excuse themselves from voting on the resolution. The Community & Home Improvement Division also recommends that organizations requesting funding and wishing to address City Council, should address Council during the public hearing.

In order to comply with federal regulations, the Community & Home Improvement Division is limiting the number of projects that communities can allocate funds for to four (4). The City currently has four projects: Minor Home Repair, Yard Services, Services for Victims of Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Sexual Assault or Stalking, and Subsistence Payments. Administration is asking City Council to approve the allocation of funding to mirror PY 2019 allocation.

\$124,632

Minor Home Repair (731227) – Provide accessibility modifications, ordinance compliance, and health and safety related repairs to low-income residents. Funds will allow approximately 50 projects to be completed. Eligible repairs include, but are not limited to, furnace or water heater replacements, roof repairs, plumbing, and electrical.

\$ 40,000 Public Services:

\$15,000 Public Services / Yard Services (732170) – Snow removal and other yard services for approximately 60 low-income senior or disabled adult households.

\$15,000 Public Services / Services for Victims of Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Sexual Assault or Stalking (730137) – Provide programs such as emergency shelter, legal, and counseling services for approximately 60 domestic violence victims or families.

\$10,000 Public Services / Subsistence Payments (730571) – Provides emergency clothing services to approximately 250 low-income residents.

All expenditures for CDBG projects are to be entirely reimbursed through CDBG revenue. The annual program year runs from July 1 to June 30.
