Architectural Classification: Greek Revival

Material Notes: Foundation is coursed cobblestone in front, random granite fieldstone in rear.

Description: 1 1/2 story rectangular plan brick house with one story rear ell. Raised basement. Two front gables with recessed porch between them. Porch has square columns and bracketed architrave, frieze, and cornice. Doors and windows within porch have corner blocks. Architrave, frieze, and cornice at roof with cornice returns. Porch on east side of rear ell, also modern deck. West side addition to rear ell with garage. 6/6 windows on front. Windows altered in rear. Two newer brick chimneys.

Other Buildings/Features: Stone pumphouse in rear. Fence with grapevines east side.

Significant Persons: Albert Terry

Statement of Significance Albert Terry came to Michigan in April 1839 and purchased the northeast quarter of section 33. He added 132 acres to his first purchase and in 1877 had a 192 acre farm that Durant described as one of the best in the township. Terry was township supervisor from 1862 to 1876. The front of the house looks as it did in Durant's history. It is an excellent example of a brick variation of the Greek Revival style.

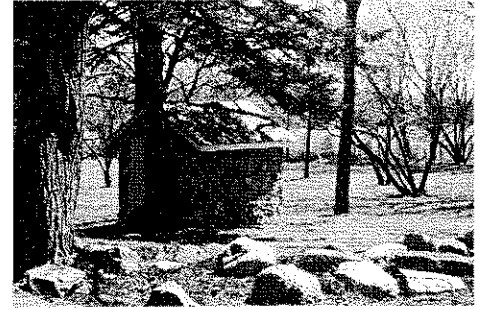
