Police and Road Millage Technical Review Committee

Under Article VII, Section .02 of the Rules of Procedure, it states that Committees shall be established by Council resolution setting for the following:

- 1. Purpose and Charge
 - a. Charge/responsibility of the Committee
 - 1) To analyze Police and Road Funding and propose short and long term strategies to City Council for review, deliberation and placement on November 2008 hallot.

Specific Items Mentioned:

- 1) Staffing levels for the Oakland County Sheriff's Department contingent in Rochester Hills for the short- and long-term future with the analysis including appropriate metrics for Rochester Hills.
- 2) Analysis of service provided as compared to the associated cost and level of safety delivered.
- 3) Review feasibility of Community Policing.
- 4) Funding levels and respective sources with particular attention to the analysis of dedicated millage funding versus general fund contributions, how other cities fund their police services and provide a recommendation that emphasizes long term sustainable funding for Police Services.
- 5) Analysis of alternative fees for service and their feasibility.
- 6) Funding levels and respective sources for Local Roads.
- 7) Alternate strategies of repair and levels of rehabilitation/replacement with respect to the PMI index achieved and resultant life span of Local Roads.
- 8) Capture of expiring debt millage for possible revenue source.
- 9) Other millage items that may be brought forth by the City Council, Administration or Public.
- b. Expected results including, but not limited to time line.
 - 2) Prepare recommendations, if any, by June 1, 2008.
 - 3) Report Monthly to City Council on Committee progress

2. Membership

- a. Each committee shall include at least two (2) and not more than three (3) Council Members.
 - Three (3) Council Members: Mr. Brennan, Mr. Rosen and Mr. Webber were appointed to this Committee on December 5, 2007.
- b. Committees shall include citizen members which shall be appointed by Council.

Four (4) Citizen Members

c. Committees may include Administrative Staff Members, which shall be appointed by the Mayor

As deemed necessary for input/assistance and maintaining "notes" for the meetings (one of whom shall be the Rochester Hills Commander).

d. Committee may include one (1) Rochester Hills Government Youth Council (RHGYC) Representative selected by the Youth Council.

One (1) RHGYC Member

e. Term of appointment, where appropriate.

Term of appointment shall be until Committee is dissolved by City Council or December 2008, whichever occurs first.
