SUBJECT: Replacement Light Trucks

REQUEST:

City Council is requested to authorize purchase of eight (8) new vehicles utilizing the Oakland County Cooperative Purchase Program. All eight vehicles will be purchased through Red Holman Pontiac GMC Toyota, Westland, Michigan in the amount of \$143,036.00.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The City purchases cars and light trucks through the Oakland County Cooperative Purchase Program. Vehicles are purchased through this program at a cost significantly lower than retail, and surplus vehicles are disposed of through the Michigan Intergovernmental Trade Network on-line auctions. Purchasing the vehicles at a discount, and selling them at public auctions results in a relatively low life cost to the City.

Reason for Selection:

Purchased through the Oakland County Cooperative Purchase Program at cost significantly lower than retail.

Method of Purchase:

Purchase Order

BUDGET:

These replacement vehicles were provided for in the 2007 fleet capital fund budget. There will be no additional staffing required. Costs for these eight items amount to \$143,036.00. Budgeted is \$205,770.
