

Several Notes

- There were actually a total of 12 companies (in 3 coalitions) during Round 2 that received resolutions for up to 15 years, however, the 12 companies chose to drop down to 12 years when they submitted the application in order to apply for zone designation with companies in their coalitions that could only obtain resolutions from their local units for 12 years. In these instances, to be technically accurate, I listed the local unit as approving a resolution for 15 years (although the 12 companies only were designated for 12 years).
- There are asterisks by three cities (Grand Rapids, Jackson, and Kentwood) that approved a certain number of years during Rounds 1 and/or 2, but decreased the number of years approved during Round 3.

*The City of Grand Rapids approved different years: During Rnds 1 & 2 = 15 yrs; Rnd 3 = 5 yrs.

**The City of Jackson approved different years: During Rnds 1 & 2 = 15 yrs; Rnd 3 = 8 yrs

***The City of Kentwood approved different years: During Rnd 2 = 12 yrs; Rnd 3 = 5 yrs
