AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 54-741 THROUGH 54-745 OF ARTICLE XII, UTILITIES, OF CHAPTER 54, FEES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN, TO MODIFY WATER AND SEWER RATES AND FEES, REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES, AND PRESCRIBE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS.
